

PINEWOOD PARK LEISURE CLUB RULES

-

1. The "Leisure Club" will be owned and operated by Douglas Wright, S Wright & W Wright to be managed and administered by such persons, as they shall nominate.
2. Memberships will be granted at the discretion of the management and members will be required to show their membership cards on each visit to the club. Their membership cards shall remain the property of the club at all times and will be returnable to the club upon termination of membership.
3. Membership will not be transferable and the management reserve the right to refuse applications and renewals of membership and terminate any membership without notice, and without giving any reason for doing so. In the case of membership being terminated it shall be at the sole discretion of the management as to whether any of the membership fee is refundable.
4. Persons under 16 years of age are permitted to use the facilities only when accompanied by an adult of 18 years and over who shall be responsible for that person's conduct at all times. Persons under 14 years may not use the gym.
5. The Club accepts no liability for any illness or injury resulting from the use of any of the Club facilities however that may have been caused. The Club accepts no liability for any illness or injury resulting from over-exertion of or precipitation of any medical condition caused by the use of the Club facilities. All persons use the facilities on the expressed understanding that it is at their own risk and members and guests are strongly advised to seek medical advice before they begin any exercise at the Club.
6. Members and guests are required to use the club facilities in a proper and reasonable manner.
7. Members and guests must be suitable attired while using the club facilities. Outdoor shoes are not to be worn on the pool side and light soled gym shoes shall be worn at all times when exercising. For hygiene reasons, it is requested that all members and guests shower before using the pool and sit on a towel when using the saunas.
8. In the interest of safety, running, diving and jumping are not allowed in the pool areas, or the use of snorkels, flippers and beach balls. Smoking and the use of drinking glasses are not allowed in the club, and members and guests should not use the facilities while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
9. No responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage to the property or valuables of any member or guest even those that may be left in the lockers provided.
10. The club reserves the right, at any time, to vary these rules, available facilities, entry fee or membership subscription or any of the charges for use of any or all the facilities.
11. The club may be closed for essential maintenance work, special functions or for any other reason as the management may feel necessary.
12. Members will further comply with any direction that the Leisure Club Staff may give to ensure the smooth operation of the Club, the use of the facilities and the convenience of all members.
13. The Manager, whose decision shall be final and binding on all members, shall determine any dispute or difference which may arise in regard to the interpretation of these rules.
14. All new members must complete a membership details form and shall be obliged to notify the Club immediately in writing of any change in the answers given.
